#### **Attendance Policy**

Class hours are condensed into a shortened time frame during the summer school session. This requires a strict attendance policy to insure that grades are valid. Listed below is the specific Summer School Attendance Policy.

- Students will be allowed three absences. Students missing more than six hours of class or, more than the equivalent of three absences will be dropped from that class without refund of tuition.
- 2. Three tardies will be the equivalent of one absence.
- 3. Tardiness of more than 20 minutes will be considered as one absence.

For example, a student will be dropped without credit or refund when he/she has:

Four absences

Three (3) absences and three (3) tardies Two (2) absences and six (6) tardies One (1) absence and nine (9) tardies Twelve (12) tardies

## **Behavior Policy**

It is expected that all students will follow school rules. Failure to do so could result in removal from the summer school program. If you are removed, you will not receive credit or a refund.

Also, if a student displays disruptive behavior, he/she will be sent home for the day. This absence will count toward total absences.
