Dear Parents and Guardians:

We want to thank you for your patience and support as we continue to work through this very fluid situation regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19). We are continuing to work with the CDC, Governor's Office and the Kent County Health Department to ensure the safety of our students, staff and community. As stated in our previous letters, our goal is to share important information without creating more stress for you and your families. We ask that you remain patient and calm because many of these topics will change daily as we receive further direction from the Governor's Office.

Because this situation keeps changing so quickly, we will be communicating with you in smaller, more frequent emails with any information that is known. Our communications will be broken down by topic so we do not flood you with too much information at one time and create even more stress. We ask that you remain patient and calm because many of these topics will change daily as we receive further direction from the Governor's Office.

This communication addresses how parents and students can access food during this time of school closure. All schools deal with strict guidelines on what food can be provided and how we can distribute those meals. We are so thankful to all those who have volunteered to help, but we are also under guidelines about who can help distribute the food. If you are wanting to volunteer, we suggest reaching out to one of the non-profit organizations around Kent County that are also assisting families with food and other resources during this situation.

Below is our plan to assist our students/families with meals during the school closure.

Our KPS Child Nutrition Services Department will provide meals to students as follows:

There will be <u>two</u> pick up days each week for our students and families. Breakfast and lunch will be provided in bulk to cover multiple days.
