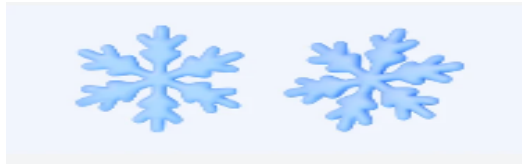


ATTENDANCE

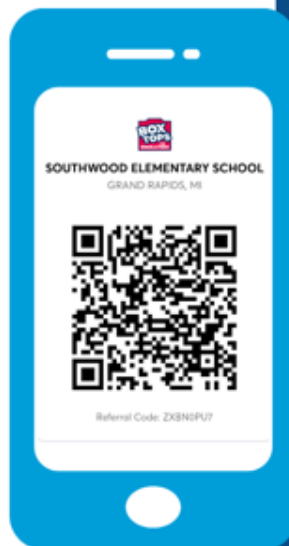
