### Dear Parents:

Your child is a student at Brookwood. You know that your child is important to us and that we want to provide every opportunity for success. Each school in Michigan is required to test students every year using the Michigan Educational Assessment Program (MEAP) tests. The results of these tests, as well as participation on the tests are used to determine whether our school is making adequate yearly progress (AYP) and where it ranks in a "Top to Bottom" list of schools and their performance. The Top to Bottom list is used to identify schools that require improvement of various kinds; some have overall low performance and others have large gaps between their high and low achieving students.

Since Brookwood is identified as a school requiring improvement the district must offer you the opportunity to transfer your child to Bowen Elementary which made AYP in the 2011-2012 school year and is not identified for improvement. If the district receives more applications than can be accommodated, priority will be given to the lowest-achieving children from low-income families. If you chose Option 1, you will be notified by mail of your child's transfer status. If you chose Option 2, you will remain at your home building (Brookwood).

To help you decide, we have provided information so you can compare them. Based on this information, you may choose a school using the enclosed transfer form. Transportation to this school will be provided. You must complete this form by August 30, 2012 and return it to Brookwood Elementary for consideration.
