Endeavor Elementary has an active Parent/Teacher Council that meets monthly with Administration and staff to discuss and plan school-wide events and discuss teaching and learning at Endeavor. Parents are encouraged to attend these meetings, serve on committees and organize events, and provide input into the learning environment at Endeavor.
