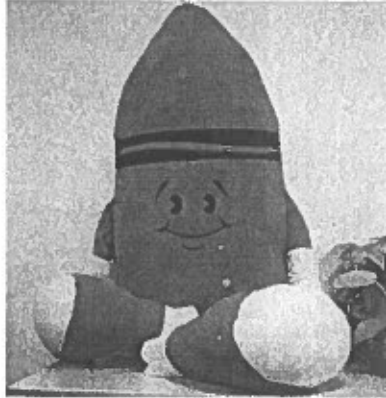


Young-Five's Supply List



- Crayola colored pencils - 12 or 24 count
- Elmer's Gluesticks - small size

**** All students will need the following items:**

- Backpack (no wheels) - standard size with name in permanent marker.
- Change of clothes (shirt, pants, socks & underwear) in a clear ziploc bag labeled with child's name - this will stay at school.
- Athletic/gym shoes for days we have physical education - they do not need to be kept at school. **No extra pair is needed** - just be sure shoes are here for gym days. I will let you know which day we will have gym the first week of school.

Note: Throughout the year we will possibly need other items such as markers, kleenex, baby wipes, hand sanitizer, ziploc bags, etc. I will send home notes as items may be needed or put a note in the monthly newsletters.

Kindergarten Supply List

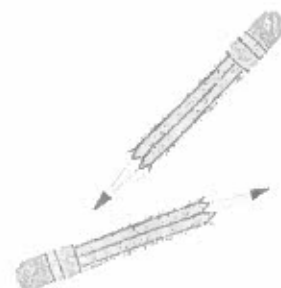

- ☐ Gym shoes

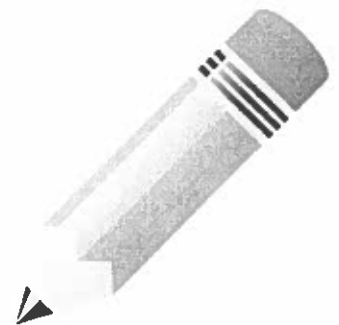


3rd Grade Supply List
